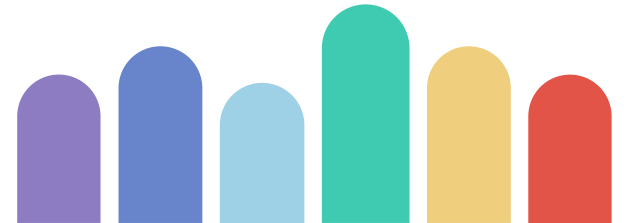

- Review of School Performance Data

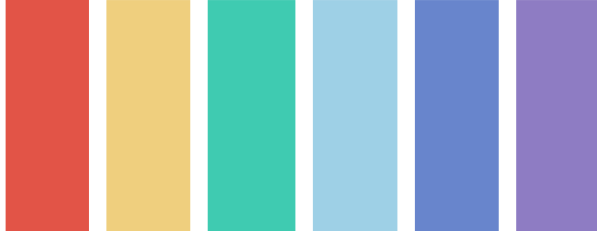
## Goals and strategies to address student academic needs
