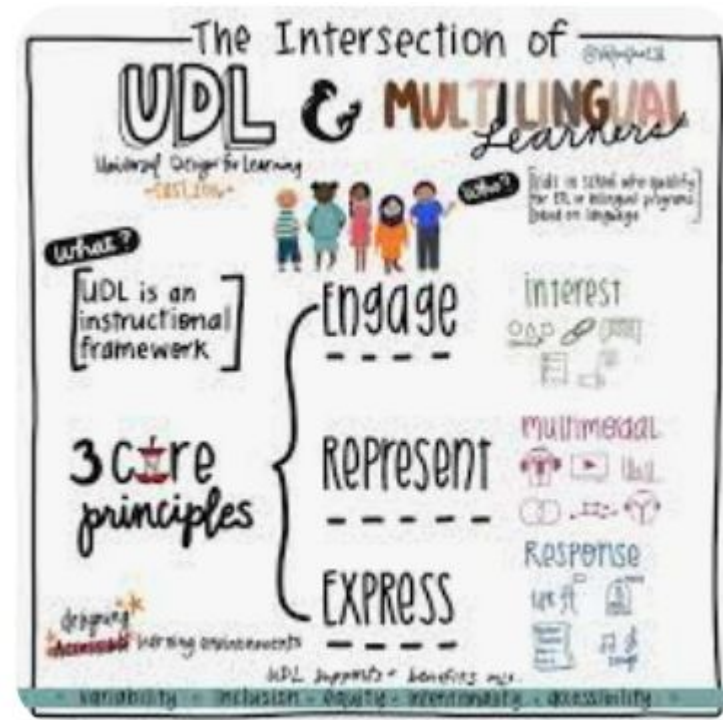

The purpose of this document is to ensure that students are learning skills to ensure that they can grow into engaged leaders and citizens, in alignment with the vision of our district.*

CATEGORIES OF RESPONSES				
<p><b>For every category, there are both Instructional Responses as well as Reduction Responses. At least one Instructional Responses must be implemented. Reduction Responses <i>may</i> also be implemented.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• “Instructional Responses” are responses focused on increasing desired behavior; requires an adult to facilitate and provide direct modeling or instruction of a skill.</li><li>• “Reduction Responses” are responses focused on decreasing undesirable behavior; punitive in nature; may or may not require an adult to facilitate.</li><li>• The lowest level response must <u>always</u> be used first.</li></ul>
